TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

Persuant to the provisions of Title 23, Vermont Statutes Anotated, Section 1007 and 1008, and Title 24, Vermont Statutes Anotated Sections 1971 and 2291 (1) (4) and (5), and such other general enactments as may be material hereto, it is hereby ordained by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Wolcott that the following traffic ordinance is hereby adopted for the Town of Wolcott, Vermont.

ARTICLE I
DEFINITIONS

The definitions of Title 23, Vermont Statutes Anotated, Section 4 are incorporated by reference.

ARTICLE II
SCOPE

The Ordinance establishes specific traffic regulations on public highways within the Town of Wolcott, Vermont.

ARTICLE III
TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to disobey the direction of a traffic control device except in response to the direction of a law enforcement officer.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to remove, injure, obstruct, deface, alter or tamper with any traffic control device.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person to install any sign or device which may resemble or be mistaken for an official traffic control device, without prior approval of the Town of Wolcott, Board of Selectmen.


ARTICLE IV
SPEED REGULATIONS

1. All vehicles will not exceed a maximum speed of 35 m.p.h. on all Class 2, 3 & 4 roads in the Town of Wolcott unless otherwise set and posted by the Town of Wolcott, Board of Selectmen.
2. The speed set on School Street and The North Wolcott Road shall remain as set and posted.


The above speed limits shall be posted in accordance with the standards set forth in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices and shall be in effect when so posted.

In accordance with 24 V.S.A. 1971-1976, and 24 V.S.A. 2291 this ordinance is adopted by the Wolcott Selectboard on 3rd day of October, 2001 to become effective sixty days from the adoption thereof.


Citizens have the right to petition for a vote on the ordinance, within 45 days, in accordance with V.S.A. Section 1973.
