Proposed Campsite

- Wolcott Selectboard received a request from the VRC regarding a proposed campsite along the Lamoille River- to be open to paddlers only. The Selectboard asked the WRC to review the proposal and make a recommendation to approve or not.
- Eric walked through the specifics of the proposed campsite.
- In addition to campsite design specifics- Eric addressed the following questions:
 - The Wolcott Athletic Association also utilizes the field and pays for the seasonal port-a-john, we need to inform them of the request and make sure they are also on board. Once the details are ironed out, the WRC will let the AA know of the proposal.
 - The following details are up to the WRC to fine tune, but generally, Eric recommended the following:
 - Clear signage- to be put up at the campsite near the river put in- not in the School Street parking lot/visible from the road.
 - Total allowed overnight at site- to be determined by the WRC, but Eric suggested 3 tent sites max, or about 6-8 people.
 - Duration of stay allowed- 2 days max stay
 - Quiet hours- to be determined by the WRC
 - Pack it in/pack it out or LNT language,
 - No overnight parking allowed,
 - Which months out of the year camping is permitted- water levels will dictate this somewhat as this site is on the northern stretch of the trail- most likely May/June.
 - Local steward- to be identified by the LRPTA and will maintain site during operation
 - Neighbors- LRPTA will contact neighbors to inform of proposal
 - Privy-WRC to follow up with AA regarding months the port-a-john is out in the field. If May/June, then site will use that facility. If not, the LRPTA will construct a privy on site and the local steward will maintain.
 - Will fees be collected for use of site?- No.
- Next steps- LRPTA will follow up with neighbors and identify a local steward. WRC will fine
 tune the site "rules" and check on use of the port-a-john. Once these details are complete,
 WRC will make a recommendation to the Selectboard. Timeframe- aiming for winter
 approval. Site construction early spring.

Elementary School Trail- Workday

 WRC to schedule a preliminary trail workday to walk the proposed trail from the Elementary School to Flat Iron Road. The purpose of this work session will be to flag trees/brush that will

- need to be removed, determine route specifics, and discuss trail signage/markings and any safety concerns.
- Maxfield has been following up with Elementary School principal- will confirm ok to move forward with the preliminary trail work day.
- Maxfield will secure parcel/tax map to confirm abutting neighbors. WRC will determine best course of action regarding contacting neighbors.
- Jackie will poll WRC for weekend work day- to also include fall planter work.

2016 Budget

- To be continued at next meeting. Brief discussion regarding: planter maintenance; covered pavilion; and composting toilet at School Street Rec Fields- similar to those at <u>Green River</u> <u>Reservoir</u>
- Proposed budget will need by complete by November- scheduled meeting with Selectboard.
